The proposed 5th alternative using more liquid rotenone and a different fish stocking strategy would be consider a “no potential to cause effects” under the National Historic Preservation Act, as amended. The Diamond Lake Fisheries Management Canal and the associated features have been determined eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. Consultation with the Oregon State Historic Preservation Officer (OSHPO) on the reconstruction of the canal has been completed. The reconstruction and use of the canal was determined to meet Stipulation III (B)(5) of the 2004 Programmatic Agreement Among the United States Department of Agriculture Forest Service Pacific Northwest Region (Region 6), the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, and the Oregon State Historic Preservation Officer regarding Cultural Resources Management in the State of Oregon by the USDA Forest Service.
