### July 25th Indian Fire Update

The Indian Fire area experienced another day of high temperature and low relative humidity without an appreciable change in fire behavior. The fire increased in size by 27 acres over the last 24 hours. The fire continues to slowly back downslope in the Cabin Creek drainage. The fire is currently 1,241 acres and is 40 percent contained.

Due to the completion of indirect line on the North and Northeast side of the fire and predicted favorable weather conditions, fire managers are considering burning out the north side of the fire on Tuesday or Wednesday. After the burnout reaches the indirect fireline, crews will be able to safely mop up the north side of the fire.

Salmon-Challis National Forest and incident management team officials are planning a public meeting on Tuesday, July 26 at the North Fork Fire Protection District Station, beginning at 6:00 pm, to discuss the current fire situation.

On July 23, the Salmon-Challis National Forest officials issued an emergency road closure in the immediate fire area to provide protection to forest visitors from the current safety hazards, such as rolling rocks and fire traffic on narrow roads.
