



Recreation fees are an investment in outdoor recreation. Current and future generations will benefit as 95% of the funds are reinvested in the facilities and services that visitors enjoy, use and value.

Accomplishments Provided with Recreation Fees on the Allegheny National Forest:

- Maintained 76 miles of trail on the Marienville District.
- Completed heavy maintenance focused on culvert repair and treadway improvements on the Marienville ATV trail.
- Completed overdue maintenance projects on 11 miles of Bradford District trails.
- Partnered with the Marienville Volunteer Fire Department to host the 15th annual Tour de Forest. These spring and fall family riding events allow the public to ride on a combination of Forest roads and ATV trails and enjoy the landscape changes displayed in two dynamic seasons.

Special Feature

It seems fitting that the islands of the beautiful Allegheny Wild and Scenic River would be designated Wilderness. Popular for dispersed camping and exploring, the dense grass and thick vegetation make access to Allegheny Islands Wilderness a challenge. These islands truly are “an area where the earth and its community of life are untrammelled by man...”
