Christmas Tree Permits for Sale on the Klamath National Forest

YREKA, CA - Christmas tree permits on the Klamath National Forest are now for sale at all forest offices. The price for each permit is \$10.00 per household, and one person may purchase Christmas tree permits for up to five households. Christmas tree cutting permits are for personal use only.

Christmas tree cutting permits may be obtained from the following ranger district offices from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (Monday – Friday):

- Happy Camp/Oak Knoll Ranger District Office, 63822 Highway 96, Happy Camp
- Goosenest Ranger District Office, 37805 Highway 97, Macdoel
- Salmon/Scott River Ranger District Office, 11263 N. Highway 3, Ft. Jones

Christmas tree cutting permits may also be obtained from the Klamath National Forest Supervisor’s Office, 1312 Fairlane Rd., in Yreka from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (Monday – Friday) and from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on **Saturday, November 26, and December 3.**

Starting on December 7, 2011, the Klamath National Forest Supervisor’s Office (or Headquarters) will be moved into their new office and will begin operations and sell Christmas trees, maps and firewood to the public. The hours of operation will remain the same at the new office and Christmas tree permits will be available for sale on **Saturday, December 10, and 17** from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The new office is located at: 1711 South Main Street, next to the California Highway Patrol building. The telephone numbers will remain the same and all public forest activities will be discontinued at the old office after December 6th.
