

Management Area	Agency	Acres	Description
Bradley Bog	TNC	40	Unique coastal wetland with <i>Darlingtonia californica</i>
Cascade Head Experimental Forest (CHEF)	SNF	7,210	Research forest related to spruce/hemlock, provides late-seral habitat for wildlife
Cascade Head Scenic Research Area (CHSRA)	SNF	6,400	Partially overlaps the experimental forest; encompasses a diversity of coastal habitats available for recreation and research
Cascade Head Preserve	TNC	280	Coastal headland grassland, dominant red fescue herbaceous community, critical habitat for silverspot butterfly
Elk Creek ACEC	BLM	1,577	Remnant old-growth parcel and bald eagle management site.
Forest Peak ACEC/RNA	BLM	134	Remnant older forest parcel adjacent to valley lowlands. Also contains small meadow.
High Peak-Moon Creek ACEC/RNA	BLM	1,538	Old-growth and mature conifers with interior forest conditions. Includes high elevation noble fir, lower elevation Douglas fir, and riparian conifer forest.
Little Grass Mtn. ACEC/RNA	BLM	45	High elevation grassland surrounded by mature Douglas-fir forest.
Little Sink ACEC/RNA	BLM	81	Remnant old-growth patch with two small slump ponds
Lost Prairie ACEC	BLM	58	Unique wetland with special botanical concerns

Management Area	Agency	Acres	Description
Mt Hebo Scenic-Biologic Special Interest Area	SNF	1,684	High elevation grasslands provides critical habitat for silverspot butterfly in a unique botanical community which includes Mt Hebo fawn lily.
Neskowin Crest RNA	SNF	686	Overlaps CHEF and CHSRA. Late-seral Sitka spruce/western hemlock forest.
Nestucca River ACEC	BLM	1,062	Special botanical concerns along riparian zone.
Reneke Creek RNA	SNF	480	Red alder riparian community with late-seral Sitka spruce forest.
Rickreall Ridge ACEC	BLM	177	Unique plant community.
Saddleback Mtn. ACEC/RNA	BLM	151	High-elevation relic silver fir forest community.
Sand Lake RNA	SNF	241	Native unstabilized dune grassland with adjacent Sitka spruce forest.
Sheridan Peak ACEC	BLM	299	Special botanical concerns, <i>Poa marcida</i> management area.
The Butte ACEC/RNA	BLM	40	Douglas-fir/grand fir and Oregon white oak plant communities.
Valley of the Glants ACEC/ONA	BLM	51	Classic old-growth forest 300-700 years old with interior forest conditions.
Walker Flat ACEC	BLM	10	Wet meadow with special botanical concerns; <i>Sidalcea nelsoniana</i> population.
