Hall Lake Trail #61

Distance: From the trailhead it is 5.2 miles to Hall Lake and 5.8 miles to the junction with Alpine Trail #7.

Difficulty: Moderate

USGS Quad: Swan Lake

Beginning Elevation: 3,160 ft


Ending Elevation: 5,480 ft Hall Lake, 5,572 ft #7

Directions: From Highway 83, just south of mile marker 72, turn east onto Fenby Lane, next to the Laughing Horse Inn, in Swan Lake. **The trailhead is located on private property one mile down the road.** Please respect posted signs.

Season: This trail is normally free of snow by mid-May.

Regulations: Hiking, horse riding and mountain biking are allowed on these trails. Motorized vehicles, including motorcycles are prohibited.

Trail Description: Hall Lake trail #61 is 5.8 miles long and starts off on private property (please be respectful when parking) and ends at the junction with Alpine Trail #7. To get to Hall Lake climb about 2,000 feet and 5.2 miles up the trail. It is about one mile from Hall Lake to the Alpine trail.


