## Hall Lake Trail \#61

Distance: From the trailhead it is 5.2 miles to Hall Lake and 5.8 miles to the junction with Alpine Trail \#7.

## Difficulty: Moderate

Beginning Elevation: 3,160 ft

USGS Quad: Swan Lake
Ending Elevation: 5,480 ft Hall Lake, 5, 5,720 ft \#7

Directions: From Highway 83, just south of mile marker 72, turn east onto Fenby Lane, next to the Laughing Horse Inn, in Swan Lake. The trailhead is located on private property one mile down the road. Please respect posted signs.

Season: This trail is normally free of snow by mid-May.

Regulations: Hiking, horse riding and mountain biking are allowed on these trails. Motorized vehicles, including motorcycles are prohibited.

Trail Description: Hall Lake trail \#61 is 5.8 miles long and starts off on private property (please be respectful when parking) and ends at the junction with Alpine Trail \#7. To get to Hall Lake climb about 2,000 feet and 5.2 miles up the trail. It is about one mile from Hall Lake to the Alpine trail.
