INTEGRATED RESOURCE CONTRACT - STEWARDSHIP

GIFFORD PINCHOT NATIONAL FOREST

The Curly Stewardship Integrated Resource Contract is located within T. 7 N., R. 6 E., Sections 12 and 13, T. 7 N., R. 7 E., Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, 30 and 32, T. 8 N., R. 7 E., Section 31, W.M., Unsurveyed, Skamania County, Washington. The Forest Service will receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at the Gifford Pinchot National Forest Headquarters, 10600 NE 51st Circle, Vancouver, WA 98682 no later than 10:00 AM local time on or before January 10, 2012 for an estimated volume of 11,724 CCF of Douglas-fir and Other Coniferous Species sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an estimated volume of 680 CCF of All Coniferous Species grn bio cv that the bidder agrees to remove at a fixed rate. Contract contains specified roads with an estimated public works construction cost of \$107,320.37. Bidders qualifying as small business concerns under the Small Business Act may, when submitting a bid, elect for the Forest Service to build permanent roads. Also included in the contract are four (4) restorative service projects. The contract will be awarded based on a Best Value determination. One award will be made to the Bidder (a) whose proposal is technically acceptable and (b) whose technical/price relationship is the most advantageous to the Government. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all proposals. Interested parties may obtain a prospectus from the office listed below. A prospectus, offer form, and complete information concerning the timber, the restoration service projects, the conditions of sale, and submission of bids is available to the public from the Gifford Pinchot Forest Headquarters, 10600 NE 51st Circle, Vancouver, WA 98682.
