Fire Danger is **EXTREME**

Check the [Fire Precaution Level](#)

As of midnight **August 1st, 2013** we will be in **Fire Precaution Level III.**

No campfires, no charcoal BBQ's, no chain saw use. Smoking is allowed inside your vehicle only

Class II vehicles are required to carry a shovel and a fire extinguisher, (or 1 gallon of water). Class IV vehicles must carry a fire extinguisher.

ATVs and Hunting

ATVs are becoming popular vehicles for hunting. Hunters must follow the same rules as other ATV operators. This includes displaying an ATV Operating permit, carrying an ATV Safety Education Card, observing the same training and equipment requirements, adhering to sound level regulations and riding only on designated routes.

Scouting and retrieving game must be done on designated trails and roads. Harvested game can be carried by hand to a road or trail and then taken by vehicle. Game shouldn't be shot if it can't be packed out. Leaving a new set of cross country tracks invites others to follow and creates a dead end trail for future riders.

Rules to follow while hunting and using an ATV:

- No hunting or harassing animals from a snowmobile, ATV or passenger vehicle.
- Do not shoot from an ATV.
- Do not shoot from or across a public right-of-way or railroad right-of-way.
- Do not carry loaded firearms on an ATV.

Note: A loaded firearm is one having live ammunition in the chamber or arrows out of a quiver (ORS 821.240) A person who has a license to carry a concealed weapon is allowed to carry a loaded firearm on an ATV.







Instructions

Use in iOS devices with the [Avenza PDF Maps App](#)
Or click the OHV area name to download the PDF file.
[Android users click here.](#)

If you have access to an iOS mobile device such as the iPad, iPhone or iPod Touch you can take some of the COHVOPS OHV Trail Maps with you using the Avenza PDF maps App.

This handy free app allows GPS equipped iOS mobile devices to:

- View your location on the PDF trail map using the built-in GPS device (iPad, iPhone, iPod Touch)
- Measure distances and areas
- Plot waypoints
- View maps offline

Here's how:



Install a QR code reader. Go to the App Store and search for QR code readers. Try: RL Classic.



Next, install the Avenza PDF Maps app. Go to the App Store, search for Avenza and install their PDF Maps app.

Open the QR code reader app and scan a QR code from the COHVOPS newsletter. The map download should begin.

Map download and processing should happen automatically in the Avenza PDF Map app. It will take a short time to process the file to make it useable in the app.

Tap the COHVOPS trail map. If you are located in the map extent your position should become apparent. You may need to refresh or update your current location.


