Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b) the following act is prohibited on the area, roads, and trails as described in this Order and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "Restricted Area") all within the McClellan Creek National Grassland, Black Kettle Ranger District, Cibola National Forest, Gray County, Texas, for the dates of December 1-5, 2011.

PROHIBITIONS

1. **Going into or being upon the restricted area. 36 CFR 261.53(e)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with a Forest Service permits specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Owners or leases of land in the area.

RESTRICTED AREA

The restricted area includes that portion to the west and south of McClellan Campground within McClellan Creek Recreation Area, which includes the OHV trailhead, called the Pit, and all of the OHV trail system; that portion west of East Bluff #1 Campground and Picnic Area within McClellan Creek Recreation Area which includes East Bluff #2, East Bluff #3, and Southside Camping and Picnic Areas on the South side of Lake McClellan; and that portion to the East of and North of State Farm Market Road 2477. The restricted area is shown on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to provide for public health and safety during the Youth Deer Hunt.

- (1) Persons with a Forest Service permits specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Owners or leases of land in the area.

RESTRICTED AREA

The restricted area includes that portion to the west and south of McClellan Campground within McClellan Creek Recreation Area, which includes the OHV trailhead, called the Pit, and all of the OHV trail system; that portion west of East Bluff #1 Campground and Picnic Area within McClellan Creek Recreation Area which includes East Bluff #2, East Bluff #3, and Southside Camping and Picnic Areas on the South side of Lake McClellan; and that portion to the East of and North of State Farm Market Road 2477. The restricted area is shown on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect resources and to provide for public health and safety during the Youth Deer Hunt.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect December 1, 2011 and shall remain in effect until December 5, 2011.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, and 3571]
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order.
