Forest Supervisor's Order

**USE OF WHEELED VEHICLES ON GROOMED SNOWMOBILE TRAILS AND ROADS**

By authority of the Secretary of Agriculture, pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following act is prohibited on all roads and trails described in this order, within the Lewis and Clark National Forest:

During the period of JANUARY 1 THROUGH APRIL 15, USE OF WHEELED VEHICLES IS PROHIBITED on the following forest development snowmobile trails and roads: [36 CFR 261.55 (b) and 36 CFR 261.54 (a)]

**ROADS/TRAILS**

- Sheep Creek Road #119 from the Forest Boundary to Calf Creek Cabin.
- Moose Creek Road #204 from the Junction of Forest Road 119 to Moose Creek Camp Ground Road #9202.
- Miller Gulch Road #831
- Newlan Creek Road #830

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.


This order is effective immediately and will remain in effect until rescinded by the Forest Supervisor.

This restriction is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart (a), section 261, Title 36, CFR.

This order supersedes Forest Supervisor's Order L&C 99-2 dated January 8, 1999.

Violations of this prohibition are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both, under authority of 16 USC 551, 18 USC 3571 and 7 USC 1011 (f).
