

ORDER NO. 11-07
LOS PADRES NATIONAL FOREST
LA BREA FIRE AREA
NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS AND TRAILS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to protect natural resources and provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Los Padres National Forest. This Order is effective from November 16, 2011, through November 15, 2012.

1. Using a motorized vehicle on any National Forest System road within the La Brea Fire Area as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map.
36 CFR 261.54(a).
2. Using a motorized vehicle on any National Forest System trail within the La Brea Fire Area as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map.
36 CFR 261.55(b).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the La Brea Fire Area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.
4. Residents in the La Brea Fire Area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their residences.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
