Dear Interested Party:

I have amended the Chequamegon-Nicolet NF Invasive Plant Control Project by adding 807 additional sites. The enclosed Decision Notice & Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) describes the details of my decision and the reasons for it. The selected action uses an integrated approach to controlling non-native invasive plants that includes a combination of manual/mechanical methods, herbicide, and release of bio-control insects. The additional 807 sites are scattered across the forest and total about 400 infested acres.

My decision is not subject to appeal pursuant to 36 CFR 215.12 because only fully supportive comments were received during the comment period. Comments received on this public action are part of the public record and therefore, are available for public inspection upon request. The implementation of the actions may begin immediately.
