Practice Respect

Winter is a magical time. You are about to enter a special place that is enjoyed by MANY recreationists but is also home to wildlife such as moose, deer, elk, and mountain lions. To protect wildlife and accommodate all the different uses, please do your part to make every interaction a positive one.



Respect for People

1. **Adopt an attitude of sharing.** We are all out here for fun and exercise. Be courteous to all - this area is not managed for just one type of use.
2. **Communicate and be friendly.** Greet people and offer thanks for responsible use. Ask before you allow your dog to approach others.
3. **Be safe.** Stay right, pass on left. Expect to encounter dogs and other people, ski in control, keep speed slow, control your dog near descending skiers, aggressive dog behavior is not acceptable (jumping, growling, nipping, etc).

Respect for Land

1. **Know the Closures.** Designated wildlife winter range is closed to all human activity. Snowmobiles are not permitted in Wilderness.
2. **Scoop the Poop.** Use mutt-mitts and deposit bags in trash.
3. **Watch for wildlife.** Be alert. Watch and listen for wildlife. Keep your distance and give animals space to move off. Control your dog.
