WINTER REGULATIONS

All human activity is prohibited in areas designated as crucial big game winter range from Dec. 1st until Apr 30th [36 CFR 261.53 (b)] \$125

Dogs found molesting or killing wildlife [36 CFR 261.8 (a)] Big Game: \$525, Small Game: \$125

Dogs must be on a six foot leash on sections of the Putt-Putt and Game Creek trails adjacent to crucial wildlife winter range between Dec. 1 and April; 30th [36 CFR 261.58 (s)] \$125

Possessing or leaving refuse, debris, or litter (including dog waste) in an exposed or unsanitary condition [36 CFR 261.11 (b)] \$175

Snowmobiling in a wilderness area [36 CFR 261.18 (a)] \$525

Operating a snowmobile in a manner that is likely to endanger people is prohibited [36 CFR 261.15 (g)] Careless: \$225, Reckless: \$525

Operating a snowmobile in a manner which damages the land, wildlife or vegetative resources is prohibited [36 CFR 261.15 (h)] \$225

Trucks, ATVs, motorcycles, and tracked vehicles are prohibited on trails designated for winter use [36 CFR 261.54 (a)] \$175


Selling or conducting any kind of work activity or service without a special use permit is prohibited (including guided activities, dog walking services, commercial filming) [36 CFR 261.10 (c)] Selling: \$225, Conducting Business: \$525

DON'T POACH THE POWDER

•Winter is a stressful time for wildlife. Deep snow, cold temperatures, and scarce food make energy conservation the key to survival. Human disturbance forces wildlife to burn energy.

•We have many options for places to recreate, but wildlife rely on the windswept hillsides to survive.

•You can help wildlife survive the winter. Respect wildlife winter range closures. Control your dog. Watch wildlife from a distance.
