

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SELECTING RESERVATION SITES

June 15th- September 7th 2018

- 1) Campsites can be requested by one party leader between the hours of 5:00 PM the day before the launch and 9:00 AM the day of your launch date.
- 2) Obtain site selection form located on this kiosk (black box to the right).
- 3) Review reservation sites listed below and select those according to your group size and your travel itinerary. To assist you in the selection process, please refer to the river map. Review the request forms that have been posted by other floaters and the campsite allocation sheet to see if other sites have already been selected. Sites that have already been posted on the allocation sheet (highlighted in red) may not be requested. Sites that have been posted by other floaters may be requested. However, same site allocation will be determined by a coin flip until one party prevails. *It is the intent of the Forest Service to have individual parties negotiate same campsite selection prior to a coin flip if possible.*
- 4) Post your request form in the designated location on the kiosk.
- 5) Checkers will remove completed request forms at 9:00 AM on your launch date and conduct compliance review. Checkers will then allocate sites once they have checked for conflict.
- 6) Groups on a 7-8 day trip may request 1 large camp after the 9:00 am camp assignments. No small groups will be assigned large camps below the South Fork.
- 7) All other campsite reservation limitations and group size restrictions apply. Parties arriving after 9:00 AM on their launch date may also reserve remaining available sites as per above. Contact the Corn Creek Checker for assistance in requesting any remaining sites.

RESERVATION PROGRAM RULES

- 1) A party that reserves a camp shall stay at that camp on the date reserved.
- 2) No party shall occupy a site that has been reserved by another party or at a reserved site that has not been allocated or reserved until after 7:00 p.m. if site is still vacant
- 3) Layovers are prohibited at reserved campsites.
- 4) Reserved campsites must be occupied by 7:00 p.m. Then vacated by 12:00 (NOON) MST.
- 5) A total of not more than 5 reserveable campsites can be reserved by a group.
- 6) **Reserved Campsites:** Permit holders may advance a single boat beyond ¼ mile of the main float party to access a campsite that has been “reserved” by that party. Permit holders that do not have a reserved site must abide by the group integrity rule.
