Directions: From Charleston, take US highway 17 North for about 25 miles to Steed Creek Road (SC Route 133-S). Turn left and drive 2.0 miles to Willow Hall Road (FS Road 202). Turn right and go 1.0 miles. Entrance will be on the left.

Facilities: 100-yard backstop, shooting tables

Season/Hours: Year round, daylight hours only


Restrictions:
