

## Your Fees at Work in 2006

### **Repair, Maintenance & Facility Enhancement**

- Added gravel to level seven campsite parking pads
- Removed an outdated restroom with a leaky vault
- Provided minor maintenance of recreation facilities such as
  - Painted 48 unit posts, and replaced 6 unit markers
  - Painted and repaired 13 picnic tables
  - Provided cleaning and pumping of four restrooms
  - Provided garbage collection at eleven campgrounds from May 14th through September 30th
  - Repaired two major water leaks to the system that serviced Medicine Lake Campground

Blue Lake Campground is a wonderful place to enjoy the outdoors and view spectacular wildlife. Nesting Bald Eagles and Osprey are common and visitors enjoy watching these beautiful birds from their campsites. Viewing opportunities are also prominent along a wheelchair accessible trail and fishing platform. A permanent viewing scope is also available along the trail.

- Relocated and improved six campsites in the Blue Lake Campground to protect a pair of nesting bald eagles

- Funded salaries for employees who conducted fee collections and compliance
