

Your Fees at Work in 2007

Repair, Maintenance & Facility Enhancement

- Operated and maintained developed recreation sites and facilities.
- Repaired picnic tables and signs at developed recreation sites.
- Purchased new signs for the Lower Santa Ynez Recreation Area.

Visitor Services

- Coordinated volunteer clean-up day at Lizard Mouth Rock Formations where graffiti and trash were removed.
- Removed three 40-yard dumpsters of trash from Arroyo Burro shooting area.

Permits & Passes

- Special Recreation Permit Fee for Nordhoff Ridge and Potrero Seco OHV Areas
- Adventure Pass and Federal Interagency Passes
- Recreation Event & Outfitter & Guide Permits

Sites/Areas

- Standard amenity fees at seven High Impact Recreation Areas and twenty-four developed day use sites
- Expanded amenity fees at thirty-four campgrounds
