

## Your Fees at Work in 2007

### **Repair, Maintenance & Facility Enhancement**

- Purchased additional vehicle control barriers for installation at Middle Creek Campground.
- Pumped toilets and repaired two fire rings at Middle Creek Campground.
- Completed hazard tree removal and fuels reduction at Middle Creek, Letts Lake, Plaskett Meadows family and Masterson group Campgrounds.
- Replaced lights, water system pressure tanks, and fans for toilets at Sycamore Campground and Camp Discovery Group Campground at the Red Bluff Recreation Area.
- Repaired picnic tables and repaired/replaced vehicle barriers at Letts Lake, Sycamore Grove and Plaskett Meadows Campgrounds.
- Repaired and/or replaced barriers at Mill Valley Campground.

### **Fee Program Success Story: Electrical Hook-ups Installed at Sycamore Campground**

The Mendocino NF used recreation fees generated at the Red Bluff Recreation Area to complete the installation of electrical hook-ups at ten campsites in Sycamore Campground. The Red Bluff Recreation Area is located directly off of Interstate 5, on the Sacramento River. It is a popular campsite for visitors looking for a one night stay along a highly traveled highway and those looking for a longer vacation along the beautiful Sacramento River. Providing electricity at selected campsites enhances the visitor's recreation experience.

- Repaired and/or replaced signing at Sycamore Grove, Plaskett Meadows, Mill Valley, Masterson, Camp Discovery and Letts Lake Campgrounds.

### ***Visitor Services***

- Hired campground hosts for Letts Lake and Sycamore Campgrounds at Red Bluff Recreation Area.

### ***Law Enforcement***

- Provided law enforcement patrols to ensure visitor and resource protection.

### ***Cost of Collection***

- Funded salaries for employees who conducted fee collections and compliance.

## **Upcoming Fee Projects**

- Continue with site improvements at all campgrounds as funds are available.
- Continue with installation of additional vehicle barriers at Middle Creek Campground.
- Complete construction of accessible sites at Eel River, Letts Lake, and Plaskett Meadows Campgrounds.

## **Recreation Fee Revenue Sources**

### ***Permits & Passes***

- Federal Interagency Passes
- Recreation Event Permits including Red Bluff Boat Drags, Float and Fly, and six OHV Enduro Events

### ***Sites/Areas***

- Expanded Amenity Fees at twelve family and three group campgrounds
- Expanded Amenity Fees at one RV dump station
- Expanded Amenity Fees at Pine Mountain Lookout Recreation Rental
