

### ***Repair, Maintenance & Facility Enhancement***

- Repairs and improvements were completed in campgrounds.
- Completed construction of several gates at campgrounds on the Summit District.

### ***Visitor Services***

- Funded Forest Service personnel who maintained campground facilities and provided visitor information.

## Fee Program Success Story: Flint Knapping Workshop

What better way to gain an appreciation of the rich archaeological heritage of Wakaluu Hep Yoo campground, then by making your own projectile point (arrowhead) with stone and antler tools! Flint knapping is more than the art of making projectile points. It is stepping into the mindprint of the Miwok hunter and visualizing a projectile in a piece of volcanic glass. The workshop was a big hit. Everyone made at least one projectile point to take home and the "inner" warrior felt the magic of connecting with ancient traditions.

- Provided portable toilets at launch sites on the Tuolumne River.
- Provided river patrols and visitor contacts on the Tuolumne River.
