

Your Fees at Work in 2008

Repair, Maintenance & Facility Enhancement

- Replaced portion of the lookout steps.
- Replaced a propane light fixture.
- Installed hardware cloth in lower and second story in preparation for making the second story available for additional sleeping space.


Visitor Services

- Provided regular maintenance service to the Calpine Lookout periodically during the year.
- Administered outfitter guide and recreation event permits.

Cost of Collection

- Funded salaries for employees who completed special use permit billing.

Fee Program Success Story: New heater for the Calpine Lookout

Funds from the rental of the Calpine Lookout facility were used to purchase and install a new propane heater. The heater will make visitors more comfortable and allows for the continued availability of this recreational facility on a year-round basis.

Upcoming Fee Projects

- Continue to implement Phase 2 of Calpine Lookout renovation – complete the middle story sleeping accommodations, adding 4-6 beds. This will change the capacity from 2 to approximately 6-8 individuals.
- Scrape sand and repaint the entire lookout.
