Recreation Program Fee Accomplishment Report 2010

Recreation fees are an investment in outdoor recreation. Current and future generations will benefit as 95% of the funds are reinvested in the facilities and services that visitors enjoy, use and value.

Accomplishments Provided with Recreation Fees on the Stanislaus National Forest:

- Performed regular operations and maintenance tasks at 12 campgrounds: cleaned toilets, provided toilet paper, pumped vault toilets, collected fees, sampled and tested water, and completed facility repairs.
- Supported campground hosts and site managers who provided visitor information and on-site presence as well as completed maintenance and cleaning tasks.
- Offered interpretive programs in the amphitheater at Wa Ka Luu Hep Yoo (Wild River) Campground.
- Completed survey and design work that allowed improvements to be made at all 12 fee campgrounds.

Described by river experts as one of the most challenging river runs in California, the main Tuolumne River is a scenic 18-mile journey. Recreation fees funded the salary of a river ranger and improved special use permit administration.
