East Kebler Pass Winter Recreation Analysis Area

Pursuant to 16 USC 551, 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and 261.50 (b) the following restrictions are in effect on and off of roads and trails located within the East Kebler Pass Analysis Area, as detailed below and further detailed in Exhibit A (map). [36 CFR 261.54(a); 261.55(a); 261.56]

EXCEPT: On County Roads.

East Kebler Pass Analysis Area is closed to dogsled and snowcat use on and off of designated forest service roads and trails (east of Copley Lake):

Township 14S., Range 87W., Section 1, Portions of Section 2 (E1/2),
Portions of Section 11 (N1/4); Portions of Section 12 (N1/4);
Township 13S., Range 87W., Section 36;
Township 13S., Range 86W., Sections 5 and 6;
Township 13S., Range 86W., Sections 32 and 33, Portions of Section 29 (SW1/4)


The intent of this order is to prevent conflicts of winter uses within the East Kebler Pass Analysis area.

Crested Butte Dispersed Winter Area

Pursuant to 38 CFR 261.50 (e), each of the following persons are exempted from this order:


1. Persons and private landowners with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


