Notes

Douglas-fir is the only designated cut species and is Leave Tree Marked with orange tracer paint marks above and below stump height. Orange painted Douglas-fir and all other species will not be cut. BT2.35, CT2.35# (Option 1).
 The ground-based machine will not be allowed on slopes greater than 30 percent, CT6.42#.
 Purchaser shall scatter or machine pile and cover landing slash, CT6.74#.
 Purchaser shall scatter slash in cutting units along Road 5800, CT6.74#.
 All system roads and trails within the sale area shall be protected, BT6.22.
 Location of all landings, tractor roads, and skid trails shall be agreed upon prior to their construction, BT6.42#.
 If purchaser chooses to tailhold on private land or land under other ownership, purchaser will have to get written permission from the landowner and provide the Forest Service with a copy of the written permission, BT6.42#.
 Location of corridors shall be approved in advance of felling operations, CT6.42#.
 Purchaser shall be required to clean equipment prior to entering National Forest Lands, BT6.35.
 Stump marks are required in all cutting units, CT6.412.
 Land lines are approximate.
