Major duties of the Grand Valley Ranger Dist. Fuels Crew include fuels reduction work such as thinning the woods with a chainsaw, feeding the slash into a brush chipper, and/or piling the slash to be burned later. The crew lays out boundaries (flags and GPS's) for contract mechanical work. The crew collects and measures fuel moisture samples twice a month. The crew performs various other duties in support of the District's needs.

The crew assists the BLM Fire Fighters in local Initial Attack fire suppression. Crew members may also be involved with off unit fire assignments lasting up to 2 weeks.

All necessary training will be provided by the agency.
