Duties: Operates complex airtanker equipment systems with numerous components that must be carefully synchronized or calibrated. Performs various aviation and ground support activities, such as servicing and operating batch mixers, tanks, and related components including pumps, valves, and hoses. Mixes, stores, inspects, tests, and delivers fire retardants to various specifications. Assists in airtanker "Hot Loading" operations. Computes, compiles, and summarizes data for preparation of recurring and special Forest Service reports and records. Monitors the safe and efficient loading of properly mixed retardant into air tankers. Operates specialized equipment used by the air tanker base, such as forklifts, aircraft tugs, aircraft auxiliary power unit, specialized aircraft firefighting equipment, retardant mixing and delivery system. Assures that equipment is in proper condition and ready for immediate use. Informs supervisor of needed requisitions, purchases, repairs, and service of equipment located at the facility.
