The trip follows the groomed upper ski trail system and will take about 1-½ hours. Program starts and ends at Grand Junction.

Interpretive rangers will discuss winter ecology, how trees, plants and animals cope with winter conditions. Also learn about tracking, history of nordic skiing, and subnivean life.

The program is free, but people need to buy a ski area trail pass to get to Grand Junction.
