

**TEMPORARY CLOSURE FOR JOJOBA BOAT RAMP AND DOCK**

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts and omissions are prohibited on the areas and roads as described in this Order, and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "restricted area"), all within the Cave Creek Ranger District, Tonto National Forest, Maricopa County, Arizona:

1. Entering or using a developed recreation site or portion thereof. 36 CFR 261.58b

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA DESCRIBED**

The restricted area includes all National Forest System lands and roads within the boundary of the Jojoba boat ramp and dock site, Tonto National Forest, as described below and depicted in Exhibit A of this Order.

Beginning at the entrance to the Jojoba boat ramp and dock proceeding North-East to the north edge of the dock then east along the north side of the dock to the waterline and South along the waterline to the edge of the pavement and then West along the edge of the pavement returning to the entrance. (N 33 50 16 W-111 38 09)

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Order is the protection of National Forest visitors and employees, the prevention of user conflicts, and the protection of property belonging to the United States due to unsafe conditions due to changes in water level.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. Prohibitions contained in this Order become effective immediately upon execution of the Order and will remain in effect until February 15, 2013 or until rescinded; if the

water level rises to a safe elevation prior to the termination date, the Forest Service can rescind the order sooner.


2. These restrictions are in addition to the general prohibitions found at 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

3. Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581].
