PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited within the area as described in this Order, and as depicted on the attached maps hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the “restricted area”), within the Cibola National Forest, in the states of New Mexico, Texas and Oklahoma.

1. Operating a vehicle carelessly, recklessly, or without regard for the rights or safety of other persons or in a manner or at a speed that would endanger any person or property. **36 CFR 261.54(f)**
2. Operating a vehicle in violation of the New Mexico, Texas, or Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Code. **36 CFR 261.54(d)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;
3. Persons engaged in a business, trade or occupation in the area;
4. (if you are going to use this exemption, you must specify the requirements).

AREA DESCRIBED

This order includes all national forest system lands located within the Cibola National Forest and Grasslands as depicted on Exhibit A and further identified as being within the boundaries of:

Mt. Taylor Ranger District
Magdalena Ranger District
Mountainair Ranger District
Sandia Ranger District
Black Kettle-McClellan Creek National Grasslands
Kiowa-Rita Blanca National Grasslands


PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect resources and to provide for public health and safety.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until January 31, 2013.
2. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for individuals and \$10,000.00 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581]
3. This Order supersedes, rescinds, and replaces any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by the Order.
