### Position Duties

- Assist Rangeland Management Specialist with riparian and upland monitoring using a variety of Techniques.

- Learn plant names with the assistance of a Rangeland Management Specialist and use them while monitoring.
- Assist other resources such as wildlife with projects.

### Do I Qualify?

- You must have proof of current enrollment or acceptance into a degree-seeking program. This means you must be already attending a university, community college, or technical/vocational school or be planning to attend the coming semester.
- Be at least a half-time student which is defined as a minimum of a 6 credit hours semester undergrad course load or a 3 credit semester graduate course load.
- You must be in good academic standing. Good academic standing is defined as a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or as otherwise defined by the school which you are enrolled.
