Fisheries

(13 STEP Positions)

People in these positions will be members of fisheries crews performing stream temperature monitoring, fish population sampling and aquatic habitat surveys. Duties will include major amounts of time working in the field collecting data with various types of equipment (GPS, two-way radios, computers, fish shockers, generators, driving of vehicles) as well as hiking, wading in streams and carrying/operating survey equipment in a safe and effective manner. Preference for consideration will be given to those individuals who live in the local area, are at least 16 years old, currently enrolled in or planning to attend High School or college this fall, have career plans, outdoor experience and/or education in fisheries and natural resource fields.

This crew will be conducting Sage grouse habitat surveys within the Leadore Ranger District. Their duty station will be located in Leadore, Idaho. Duties will include major amounts of time working in the field collecting vegetation and habitat data, hiking, carrying and operating survey equipment in a safe and effective manner. Preference for consideration will be given to those individuals who are at least 16 years old, currently enrolled in, or planning to attend, High School and/or college this fall, are planning for careers in natural resources, have outdoor experience, and education in Wildlife, botany or other natural resource fields.
