### Duties (Timber Sale Preparation):

- Responsible for preparing timber sales for the Districts
- Implement silvicultural prescriptions while marking and cruising timber
- Unit boundary and cut or leave tree designation. Record tree heights, diameters, and species
- Use of clinometer, diameter-tape, BAF prism, relaskop, marking gun, and increment borer will be a necessity. Training will be provided
- Traversing timber sale units will be performed using Global Positioning Systems
- Planting /transplanting seedlings, reforestation surveys, and forest health surveys

### Duties (Timber Stand Improvement):

- Performing hazard tree inventory and/or tree felling along popular Forest trails and roads
- Responsible for performing stand improvement activities such as felling small un-merchantable material left following harvest activities and construction of buck and rail fences to protect regenerating stands
- Reforestation surveys, stand exams, forest health plots, site preparation, and other timber sale related duties
