Duties for these positions consist of a variety of projects in support of the wilderness program including:

- Contact users to provide information and to enforce rules and regulations
- Maintain and construct trails
- Maintain wilderness signs and trailheads
- Rehabilitate wilderness campsites and pick up trash
- Wilderness patrol
