**ACCESSIBLE AREAS FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED: ♿**

**Oaks Picnic Area:** Day Use only.

**West Fork Road:** Access for the disabled is available by permit at the San Gabriel River Ranger District located in Glendora. Glenn Camp has three sites available for disabled.

**ROADS:**

**Highway 39: Open to Crystal Lake Road junction (mm 38.13).**

**Crystal Lake Road: Open**

**East Fork Road: Open**

**Glendora Mtn Road: Open**

**Glendora Ridge Road: Open**

**Mt. Baldy Road: Open.**

**OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE AREAS & ROUTES:**

Registration and Forest Service approved spark arrestors are required. ATV and dirt bike riders must wear a helmet. ATV riders under age of 18 must complete a safety course. All vehicles must meet local, State and Federal laws.

***No Alcoholic beverages are allowed.***

Areas may be closed at any time due to unsafe conditions caused by storms, fire danger or excessive use capacity.

**San Gabriel Canyon OHV Area:** Saturday/Sunday 8 am to posted hours. All vehicles must exit the area by 4:30. **FEES:** \$8.00 for the Primary vehicle and \$5.00 for each additional vehicle.

## **SAN GABRIEL RIVER RANGER DISTRICT (SGRRD) continued:**

### **Rincon/Shortcut OHV Route: Rincon & Shortcut Road is **CLOSED** until further notice.**

Restricted vehicle access: 4x4, Pick-up, Jeep, and red/green sticker vehicles (atv, dirt bikes, etc.). Special permit with a combination may be obtained at the District Office & Gateway (located north of Azusa). Provide current Driver's license and Vehicle registration.

Vehicles entering and exiting at *night* must have functional head lamps and tail lights. **Vehicles parked along the route must display an Adventure Pass.**

**CAMPGROUNDS:** Propane and pressurized gas stoves allowed. Must have immediate source of water/soil at all sites.

***Coldbrook Campground:*** Open. ***No drinkable water.*** First Come/First Serve. \$12.00 per site for one vehicle and \$5.00 for second vehicle. Pit toilets. Stream water available...must be treated before drinking. Fire in the fire ring (bring your own wood) and charcoal in the grill provided by the Forest Service.

***Crystal Lake Campground:*** Closed for Overnight camping. Open for Day-Use.

***No drinkable water. Gate access is between 6:00 am to 6:00 pm.***

A Daily Adventure Pass is required and may be purchased at the Crystal Lake Information Station (Saturday & Sunday) and Crystal Lake Store (closed Monday). The Annual AP, Interagency-America the Beautiful and Golden Passport will be accepted.

Loops A & B campsites: **Day-Use only.** No vehicle access; walk-in only. Fire is allowed in the fire ring (bring your own wood) and charcoal in the grill provided by the Forest Service.

Access to the lake is 1 mile walk or bike-in only, ***no vehicles.***

***Glenn Trail Camp:*** Open. First-come/first-serve. Ten sites available. Three sites are handicap accessible. Access is hike-in or bicycles. Vehicle access with permit for disabled. Pit toilets and stream water available. Fire in the fire ring and charcoal in the grill located at the site. ***Campfire permit is required.***

***Manker Flats Campground:*** Closed for the winter.

## **RIVERS and STREAMS:**

### **FISHING:**

A valid California fishing license is required. For **stocking information**, contact the California State Fish and Game Department at (562) 594-7268.

***West Fork:*** Only ***artificial flies or lures with a single barbless hook*** may be used in the West Fork and its tributaries. From the second crossing up it is "***Catch and Release***" only.

***East Fork:*** Open

***North Fork:*** Open.

***San Gabriel Dam:*** North shoreline only.

***San Antonio River:*** Open

***Crystal Lake:*** Open. No swimming. Hike in only; 1 mile.

**TARGET SHOOTING:**

**Burro Canyon Shooting Park:** Thursday through Monday, from 9 am to 4 pm. For further information call (626) 910-1344.

**PICNIC AREAS:**

**The Oaks:** 14 group picnic sites for *Day-Use Only*. No camping. Restrooms are available. Charcoal allowed in the grills provided. **No wood fires.** Propane and pressurized gas grills or camp stoves are allowed. An Adventure Pass or Interagency Passport is required.

**HIKING TRAILS:**

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** For safety reasons, hiking trails are **not** recommended for equestrian or bicycle travel. **High elevation trails may require snowshoes and/or crampons:**

*Mt. Baldy* trails and peak: Open.

*Cucamonga Wilderness trails:* Open. Wilderness Permit required.

*Icehouse Canyon:* Open. Wilderness Permit required.

*Bridge to Nowhere (Sheep Mountain Wilderness):* Open. Wilderness Permit required.

***West Fork Road and Bear Creek trails:***

*Upper Bear Creek Trail (off Hwy 39) Open to creek (5.5 miles one-way).*

*Lower Bear Creek Trail (off the West Fork) Open.*

*Crystal Lake Area trails:* Open.
