Subject: Approval of Recreation Fee Changes

The Southern Region Recreation Resource Advisory Committee (RRAC) held its second meeting September 26-27, 2007. The committee reviewed proposals to initiate new fees or modify existing fees. The Southern Region RRAC formally recommends the 15 fee changes listed below.



Forest/State	Site Name & Type	Recommended Change
Daniel Boone National Forest, Kentucky	Bee Rock Campground	Increase camping fees to \$8/night/single site and \$12/night/double site.
	White Sulphur & Redbird Crest OHV Trail Systems	Increase fees to \$7/operator/day, \$15/3 days, \$40/adult annual, and \$20/youth annual (under age 16). To receive the discount, youth must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian and have passed an approved rider safety training program. The permit would be valid for both trail systems.
Kisatchie National Forest, Louisiana	Loran Campground	Increase camping fee to \$7/night/site
	Turtleslide Campground	Increase camping fee to \$10/night/site
	Beaver Dam Campground	Increase camping fee to \$15/night/site (\$11 basic fee & \$4 for hook-ups)
	East & West Kincaid Lake Boat Launches	Increase day use fees at the East and West Kincaid Boat Launches to \$3/tow vehicle
	Camp Livingston Multiple Use Trail System, Claiborne Trail System, Sandstone Trail, and the Enduro Trail	Increase fees to \$5/OHV, horse, mountain bike operator/day; \$50 adult annual, and \$25/youth annual (under age 16). To receive the discount, youth must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian and have passed an approved rider safety training program.
National Forests in Mississippi	Marathon Lake, Shongelo, Ashe Lake, Clear Springs, Turkey Fork, Chewalla Lake, Puskus Lake, Choctaw Lake, and Davis Lake Recreation Areas	Increase day-use fees to \$5/vehicle/day or \$50 for an annual pass honored at all day-use sites within Mississippi National Forests. The increase at Ashe Lake will not be implemented until January 1, 2009.
	Marathon Lake, Big Biloxi, Clear Springs, Turkey Fork, Chewalla Lake, Choctaw Lake, and Davis Lake Recreation Areas	Increase camping fees to \$20/night/site (\$14 basic fee & \$6 for hookups). The increase at Big Biloxi will not be implemented until January 1, 2009.
National Forests in North Carolina	Cheoah Point, Cherokee Lake, Hanging Dog, Jackrabbit, Kings Mountain, Mortimer, Murray Branch, Sycamore Flats, Pink Beds	New picnic shelter rental fee; \$35 half day; \$50 entire day. The national reservation system fee is included in these prices.
	Cradle of Forestry-Special Event Fees	Increase event fee to \$6/adult and \$3/youth (under 16); increase to \$7/adult & \$3.50/youth in two years. If the additional increase has not occurred in two years, the proposal must come back before the RRAC.
National Forests in Florida	Camel Lake & Wright Lake Campgrounds	Increase camping fees to \$10/night/basic site at both campgrounds & \$15/night for sites with hook-ups at Camel Lake.
	Delancy East, Farles Prairie, Hopkins Prairie, Big Bass Campgrounds	Increase and standardize the basis for camping fees to \$10/night/site.
	Lake Eaton & Shanty Pond Campgrounds	Increase camping fees to \$8/night/site
Chattahoochee -Oconee National Forest, Georgia	OHV Annual Pass, all seven OHV trails with current user fees	Offer optional annual pass for \$50/year; no change in daily fee
