The High Sierra Ranger District, Sierra National Forest Aquatics Program is looking for two qualified biological technicians (fisheries) to conduct stream surveys and various other field work on the Forest for approximately 4-5 months (approximately May 21 to September 30 (or longer if funding is available)) during the summer of 2012. Salaries range from \$15.00 (GS-5) to \$18.59 (GS-7) per hour. Government housing will be available.

Minimum Requirements:

GS-5: Bachelor's degree in Biological Sciences or Fisheries Management, or 1 year experience as a GS-4. At least 6 semester units in fisheries related courses.

GS-7: 1 year of graduate-level education *or* superior academic achievement, or 1 year equivalent to at least GS-5. At least 6 semester units in fisheries related courses.

Over 18 years of age, valid driver's license, and a U.S. Citizen.

These positions will be based in Prather, CA (Barracks at Shaver Lake).
