

Order No. 03-12-08
Eldorado National Forest
Meadow Road and Trail Closures

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited on the Eldorado National Forest. This Order is effective from July 11, 2012 through August 31, 2012.

1. Using any wheeled motorized vehicle on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown on Exhibits A through Z and Exhibits H1, H2, I1, I2, N1, N2, N3, Z1, Z2, AA, BB, CC, DD, EE, FF, GG1, GG2, HH, II, and JJ.
 - a) Forest Road No. 8N23B (Exhibit A).
 - b) Forest Road No. 8N35 (Exhibit B).
 - c) Forest Road No. 9N01, beginning at a point 1.2 miles west of the east start of the road, then continuing northwest 1.0 miles to the end of road, as shown on Exhibit C.
 - d) Forest Road No. 9N04 (Exhibit D).
 - e) Forest Road No. 9N08 (Exhibit E).
 - f) Forest Road No. 9N15 (Exhibit F).
 - g) Forest Road No. 9N54, from the west start of the road, then continuing 1.3 miles, as shown in Exhibit G.
 - h) Forest Road No. 9N82, from the northeastern start of the road, then continuing southwest 9.46 miles and from the southwest end of the road, then continuing northwest 0.6 miles, as shown in Exhibit H1 & H2.
 - i) Forest Road No. 9N83 beginning at a point 0.3 miles south of the north start of the road, then continuing south 2.88 miles, as shown on Exhibit I1 & I2.
 - j) Forest Road No. 9N95 (Exhibit J).

 - l) Forest Road No. 10N03, from the northwest start of the road, then continuing southeast 0.5 miles, as shown on Exhibit L.

36 CFR 261.55(b).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local law officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
