

Emmett Ranger District Seeks Input on Outfitter and Guide Proposal

The Emmett Ranger District has received an unsolicited proposal to conduct outfitted and guided bear and mountain lion hunting on the Boise National Forest. As per Forest Service regulations, the Emmett Ranger District is required to determine if competitive interest exists prior to moving forward with the approval process.

The unsolicited proposal included day trips for a maximum of two mountain lion and two bear harvests per year and predator hunts on National Forest System Lands within Idaho Fish & Game Units 32 and 32A. All accommodations for clients will be in Emmett, ID. All travel to be in accordance with current Motor Vehicle Use Map for the Boise National Forest.
