Yurt --Located 4.5 miles past the winter gate (which is just above the Maple Grove parking area). Elevation is 7,520 feet.

Capacity - Maximum 8 people, 4 - 4 ft. by 7 ft. bunks (2 double- bunk beds)

Rental Fee - \$75.00, includes 4 vehicle passes.

Amenities - wood heating/cooking stove, table and benches

Hiking - Trailhead to the Red Pine Road, Little Water and Big Water trails.

Restroom - Next to yurt.
