

Salmon River Road Bridge Replacements at Pine and Cove Creek

Construction crews are back and will be working hard to finish Pine and Cove Creek bridges, as well as, remove the existing structures this season. Men and equipment began showing up on the job site on Monday, April 23rd. Six of the twelve girders for Cove arrived Thursday, April 23rd and were set near the bridge for placement. On Monday, April 30th six additional will arrive and that night, starting at 8:00 PM, they will be assembled and set across the river; the original six will be placed on Tuesday night.

The same process begins at Pine Creek beginning Monday, May 7th with girders spanning the river by Friday the 10th.

Normal Construction hours will be Monday through Thursday 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM. Flaggers will be present.

Traffic control for May is as follows:

- 6:00 AM to 8:00 AM the road is open;
- 8:00 AM to 12 noon up to four (4) hour delays may be necessary;
- 12 noon to 1:00 PM the road is open;
- 1:00 PM to 8:00 PM up to 4 hour delays permitted;
- 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM the road is open.

Exceptions: the road will be closed from 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM for night work.

Monday April 30th: Bookers to Cove Creek Landing (Cove Creek Bridge)

Tuesday May 1st: Bookers to Cove Creek Landing (Cove Creek Bridge)

Monday May 7th thru Thursday May 10th: Pine Creek Bridge (Closure will be made at a turnaround area on each side of the existing structure.)

EMS traffic will be assisted thru the closure areas as quickly as possible.

Please drive carefully, watching for construction crews and flaggers along the Salmon River Road and the Bridge Replacement Areas.
