Area Closure Order

A. PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads and trails described in this order, in the Bridgeport Ranger District, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, beginning at 8:00 am on May 10, 2012 and terminating at 4:00pm on May 10, 2012.

1. Going into or being upon any area which is closed for the protection of:

- g. The privacy of tribal activities for traditional and cultural purposes.
[36 CFR 261.53(g)]**

B. EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following is exempt from this order.

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act of omission;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons invited by the Yerington Paiute Tribe to participate in the event.

C. AREA DESCRIBED

All areas, roads and trails that cover approximately 1 acre in size, located west of Forest Road 42050 and east of Desert Creek, near the junctions of Forest Road 42050 and 42050P, that lie within the southwest 1/4 of the southwest 1/4, or the northwest 1/4 of Section 4, Township 8 North, Range 24 East, on the Bridgeport Ranger District, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest map as shown on Exhibit A.

D. PURPOSE

To protect the privacy of tribal activities for traditional and cultural purposes.

E. IMPLEMENTATION

1. This order is effective from 8am until 4pm on May 10th, 2012.
2. Exhibit A, Map, is attached and incorporated into this ORDER.

Any violation of this order is punishable as a class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization and/or imprisonment of not more than 6 months [16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].


