

Notes

Subdivision boundary coincides with cutting unit boundary, B.1.
 All off-road equipment shall be cleaned prior to entering the Contract Area, G.3.5.
 All system roads and trails within the Contract Area shall be protected, G.2.2.
 Contractor shall scatter or pile and cover landing slash in entire Contract Area, K-G.7.4.2# (Option 2).
 Location of all landings and skid-trails shall be agreed upon prior to their construction, G.4.2.2.
 Location of corridors shall be approved in advance of felling operations, K-G.4.2#.
 If contractor chooses to tailhold on private land or land under other ownership, contractor will have to get written permission from the landowner, K-G.4.2#.
 Specified roads are subdivision R/W.
 Stump marks are required in all subdivisions, K-G.4.1.7.
 Land lines are approximate.
 * Dust Abatement is required on road 3415 from Highway 34 to beginning of Alesia Bridge (approximately 400 ft), K-F.3.1 #
 A gate on road 3310 may be installed during the Missouri Thin STWD contract under a separate contract. If gate is installed, protect improvement, G.2.2.
