


# Bear Camp Coastal Route



**Motorist Advisory**

- The Bear Camp Coastal Route is a narrow, winding, remote mountain road that is not maintained for winter travel, typically between November 5 and May 31. No services are available.
- Roads in the area may be impassable due to snow accumulation, debris or rock slides and other environmental conditions.
- U.S. Route 199 and U.S. Highway 101 are recommended for trailers, motor homes, and oversized vehicles year-round and for all vehicular travel during winter months.
- Several gates are closed seasonally on area roads to protect resources or restrict travel in areas prone to land slides; three seasonally closed gates are included on this map.
- Be prepared for emergency situations. Check weather reports and take food, water, and survival gear with you when visiting public lands. Inform someone of your travel plans including your destination and expected time of return.
