COST SHARE AGREEMENT FOR THE SANTA ANITA FIRE INCIDENT.

This cost share agreement between the Department of Agriculture, United States Forest Service (USFS) and the City of Sierra Madre was prepared under the following guidelines:

1. In accordance with the following Master Agreements:
 - A. Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement between the Angeles National Forest and Sierra Madre Fire Department and their Annual Operating Plan.
 - B. California Disaster and Civil Defense Master Mutual Aid Agreement.
 - C. "California Master Cooperative Wildland Fire Management and Stafford Act Response Agreement" between the USDA Forest Service, USDI Bureau of Land Management, USDI National Park Service, USDI Fish and Wildlife Service, USDI Bureau of Indian Affairs, and the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE).
2. All costs originating from orders placed by and for the incident that can be reasonably obtained and estimated for the cost share period will be included in this agreement and will be shared on the basis of the Agency Administrators mutual agreement.
3. Costs for non-expendable property purchases by each agency will be charged direct to that agency and will not be shared.
4. Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged in joint fire suppression activities will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement.
5. Agency specific costs will not be shared.
6. Responsibility for tort claim costs or compensation for injury costs will not be a part of and will be determined outside of this agreement.
7. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
8. Costs for repair of agency owned equipment is the responsibility of the owning agency. It is not a part of and will be determined outside of this agreement.
9. The costs attributable to the Federal Interagency Incident Fire Team 3 that was ordered by Sierra Madre Fire Department as Assistance by Hire will be paid by the United States Forest Service. All reimbursement made by the United States Forest Service for the Team will be sharable costs and will be included in the cost pool.
10. All costs attributable to the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) Mobile Kitchen Unit (MKU) will be billed to the City of Sierra Madre. All reimbursement made by the City of Sierra Madre for the MKU will be sharable costs and will be included in the cost pool.
11. The California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) costs incurred for hotels from April 26, 2008, through May 2, 2008, will be billed to the City of Sierra Madre. Any reimbursement made by the City of Sierra Madre will not be sharable and will not be included in the cost pool.
12. All ground and air resources that responded under the Master Mutual Aid Agreement or as a "Good Neighbor" will not be billed to or reimbursed by either the United States Forest Service or the City of Sierra Madre. Any costs or associated costs are not sharable and will not be included in the cost pool.

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13. All resources that responded to the incident that did not receive a resource order number through ROSS during the incident are not billable or reimbursable by either the United States Forest Service or the City of Sierra Madre.
14. In recognition of their responsibility under the Master Mutual Aid Agreement, the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) will incur all the costs associated with the following resources. These costs will not be billed to or reimbursed by either the United States Forest Service or the City of Sierra Madre. Any costs or associated costs are not sharable and will not be included in the cost pool.

All the costs associated with the County of Los Angeles Fire Department resources that were identified in Number 16 above that were converted under CFAA on April 28, 2008, will be paid for by the United States Forest Service for use from April 28, 2008, through May 2, 2008 as assistance by hire. All reimbursement made by the United States Forest Service for these resources will be sharable costs and will be included in the cost pool.

COST SHARE AGREEMENT FOR THE SANTA ANITA FIRE INCIDENT.

18. All the costs associated with the following resource are attributable to the Los Angeles City Fire Department for the resource that responded under the Master Mutual Aid Agreement from April 26, 2008, through April 27, 2008. These costs will not be billed to or reimbursed by either the United States Forest Service or the City of Sierra Madre. Any costs or associated costs are not sharable and will not be included in the cost pool.

19. All the costs associated with the Los Angeles City Fire Department resource that were identified in Number 18 above that were converted under CFAA on April 28, 2008, will be paid for by the United States Forest Service for use from April 28, 2008, through April 30, 2008. All reimbursement made by the United States Forest Service for this resource will be a sharable cost and will be included in the cost pool.
20. All the costs attributable to the fixed wing resources will be paid for by the United States Forest Service. All reimbursement made by the United States Forest Service for the fixed wing resources will be sharable costs and will be included in the cost pool.
21. All costs attributable to rotary wing resources, other than the resources that responded under the Master Mutual Aid Agreement, will be paid for by the United States Forest Service. All the reimbursements made by the United States Forest Service for the rotary wing resources will be sharable costs and will be included in the cost pool.
22. Notwithstanding any other condition within this agreement, the final actual costs between the United States Forest Service and City of Sierra Madre will be based on the proportionate acreage burned within the jurisdictional boundaries of each agency.
23. An administrative charge, the pre-established percentage set by each agency, will be applied pursuant to agency policy by the agency issuing the settlement billing for the net amount owed.
24. Within 5 months the parties to this agreement will meet to determine the total actual costs of each agency. The agency, whose total actual costs exceed their proportional share of the overall incident final costs, as determined within this agreement, will bill the other agency. The billing, when paid, will result in each agency sharing overall incident costs as herein agreed.
25. The following agencies will be responsible for collecting actual cost/expenditure data that will make up the cost pool of shareable costs.


