COST SHARE AGREEMENT for the **SESNON** Incident.

1. Under a "You Order, You Pay" cost sharing agreement, the responsible jurisdictional agencies, (Los Angeles Fire Department LFD, Los Angeles County Fire Department LAC, and Ventura County Fire Department VNC) will be responsible for the following:

- A. In recognition of their responsibility to protect the City of Los Angeles, the cost share for which the Los Angeles Fire Department is responsible, shall be met through the city's contribution of Los Angeles Fire Department resources brought to the incident. The City of Los Angeles will not bill the State of California for Los Angeles Fire Department resources, including aircraft, utilized on this incident.

- B. In recognition of their responsibility to protect the County of Los Angeles, the costs attributed to the Los Angeles County Fire Department and itemized in Attachment "A" to this agreement will be considered the financial responsibility of Los Angeles County Fire Department. This amount represents their share of resources that were necessary to protect structures in the State Responsibility Area (SRA) of Los Angeles County. This amount cannot be billed to or reimbursed by CALFIRE. Outside of this condition, the Los Angeles County Fire Department may bill CALFIRE for other resources assigned to the SESNON FIRE as allowed for by their Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement and Operating Plan.

- C. In recognition of their responsibility to protect the County of Ventura, the costs attributed to the Ventura County Fire Department and itemized in Attachment "B" of this agreement will be considered the financial responsibility of the Ventura County Fire Department. This amount represents their share of their resources that were necessary to protect structures in the State Responsibility Area (SRA) of Ventura County. This amount cannot be billed to or reimbursed by CALFIRE. Outside of this condition, the Ventura County Fire Department may bill CALFIRE for other resources assigned to the SESNON FIRE as allowed for by their Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement and Operating Plan.

COST SHARE AGREEMENT for the SESNON Incident.



The intent of Paragraph "B" of the Cost Share Agreement for the Sesnon Incident is that the Los Angeles County Fire Department (LAC) will:

Determine which LAC resources were providing "structure protection" on State Responsibility Area (SRA) lands within Los Angeles County

Identify which LAC resources would meet LAC's responsibility and incur the direct cost associated with such resources

To determine which LAC resources were providing "structure protection" on SRA within Los Angeles County, each Incident Action Plan (IAP) was reviewed. It was determined that during the course of the entire incident period, LAC had 17 Type 1 Engine "days" (24 hour periods) that were performing "structure protection" on SRA within Los Angeles County.

Therefore, to meet its responsibility as intended by the Cost Share Agreement, LAC will incur the direct cost associated with LAC ST1109A and LAC ST1103A.
