This cost share agreement between the Department of Agriculture, United States Forest Service (USFS), the State of California, Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE), Consolidated FPD of Los Angeles County, Los Angeles City Fire Department, Glendale City Fire Department, and Pasadena City Fire Department was prepared under the following guidelines:

1. In accordance with the California Master Cooperative Wildland Fire Management and Stafford Act Response Agreement (CFMA) between the USDA, Forest Service, USDI, Bureau of Land Management, USDI, National Park Service, USDI, Fish and Wildlife Service, USDI, Bureau of Indian Affairs, and the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE).
2. In accordance with the Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement between the USDA, Forest Service Angeles National Forest and the Consolidated FPD of Los Angeles County.
3. In accordance with the Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement between the USDA, Forest Service Angeles National Forest and the Los Angeles City Fire Department.
4. In accordance with the Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement between the USDA, Forest Service Angeles National Forest and the Glendale City Fire Department.
5. In accordance with the Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement between the USDA, Forest Service Angeles National Forest and the Pasadena City Fire Department.
6. Responsibility for tort claim costs or compensation for injury costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside of this agreement.


7. Suppression and non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency.
8. In recognition of their responsibility to protect the City of Pasadena, the Pasadena Fire Department will incur the costs associated with all of their assigned agency resources and "exclusive use contracts" supplied to the incident for the duration of the incident.
9. In recognition of their responsibility to protect the City of Glendale, the Glendale Fire Department will incur the costs associated with all of their assigned agency resources and "exclusive use contracts" supplied to the incident for the duration of the incident with the exception of request #E-360 (Ambulance).
10. In recognition of their responsibility to protect the City of Los Angeles, the Los Angeles Fire Department will incur the costs associated with all of their assigned agency resources and "exclusive use contracts" supplied to the incident for the duration of the incident with the exception of those resources listed on Attachment A.
11. In recognition of their responsibility to protect the County of Los Angeles, the Consolidated FPD of Los Angeles County will incur the costs associated with all of their assigned agency resources and "exclusive use contracts" supplied to the incident for the duration of the incident with the exception of those resources listed on Attachment B and those identified in paragraph 14, which will be paid by the USDA, Forest Service.
12. The Consolidated FPD of Los Angeles County, the City of Los Angeles, the City of Glendale, and the City of Pasadena, to assist them in the protection of their respective jurisdictions, ordered additional resources through the State Fire And Rescue Mutual Aid System (Mutual Aid Resources) as listed on Attachment D. These resources are not billable to the USDA, Forest Service or CAL FIRE.
13. In recognition of their responsibility to protect the States Direct Protection Area, CAL FIRE will incur the costs associated with all of their assigned agency resources and "exclusive use contracts" supplied to the incident for the duration of the incident with the exception of those resources listed on Attachment C.
14. On Tuesday September 8, 2009, @ 18:00 hours the Station incident went back to single command (USFS). Any resources ordered after that time were given a unique request number (7000 series) in ROSS and will be reimbursed by USDA Forest Service upon presentation at assistance by hire rates.
15. Consolidated FPD of Los Angeles County further agrees not to bill or seek reimbursement from CAL FIRE for any of the Consolidated FPD of Los Angeles County resources used on the Station incident.

COST SHARE AGREEMENT for the Station Incident

16. CAL FIRE and the USDA, Forest Service both agree not to bill or seek reimbursement from Consolidated FPD of Los Angeles County for any resources used on the Station incident.
17. Agency resources include air, ground and support resources. USFS will pay for all other resources, logistical support costs and associated costs for the incident not otherwise outlined in this agreement.
18. If this fire becomes active and grows in size, this agreement can be renegotiated at the request of any of the signatory parties.

This cost share agreement is our best judgment of agency cost responsibilities.


