


## ATTENTION BLUE RIDGE RECREATION USERS

The US Forest Service will be implementing a forest health and fuels reduction project along the Blue Ridge Road and near the upper slopes of the Mt. High Ski Resort (West). The project work will be performed by contractors and will occur in the early summer months of 2012. Activities associated with the project will include tree felling and chipping of wood material which involve the use of heavy equipment and can be hazardous to any persons in the area.

If you plan to recreate in this area, please take caution and follow all signs posted regarding dangers associated with the project and potential hazards. Please follow all traffic control patterns for vehicles and bicycles using the Blue Ridge Road. Work along with Pacific Crest Trail (PCT) will be completed before the Memorial Day weekend. Caution should be taken by hikers by staying on the PCT to ensure your safety from the nearby activity.



A map of the project areas is shown for your reference. Activity will be concentrated in the pink and blue areas but may occur along Blue Ridge Road throughout the span of the project.
