### **High Water Warning**

As we head into the next few weeks, please use caution near streams and rivers. The snow is melting fast. Rivers are high and swift. Please keep your eye on children and animals when recreating near water.

Henrys Fork Trail to Kings Peak:

Henry's Fork Basin and King's Peak still covered in snow. Last quarter mile to Elkhorn Crossing is covered in deep snow. Foot Bridge is inaccessible. River is high and swift. Trail is still very wet.














China Meadow's:

**Camping in dispersed areas on the Forest is allowed for fourteen (14) days in any thirty (30) day consecutive period. Campers must move off Forest after reaching the 14-day limit. The stay limit also applies to all camping equipment (tents, chairs, ATVs, ATV trailers, etc.), even if used by a different person or group. Camping equipment must be removed by the end of the fourteen (14) day stay limit or the equipment may be impounded. Stay limits are implemented to reduce impacts to vegetation and wildlife habitat, as well as provide access to popular campsite areas for other visitors.**

### **Utah Off-highway Vehicle (OHV) Law**

**Beginning Jan. 1, 2023, Utah will require all OHV operators to complete the Utah Off-Highway Vehicle Education Course. Operators under the age of 18 shall possess a youth OHV education certificate in order to operate an OHV on public land, road or trail. Operators 18 years of age or older may operate an OHV if they possess an approved adult OHV education certificate. The test will be available beginning January 1, 2023.**

#### **Certified Weed Free Hay:**

To prevent the spread of noxious weeds into the ecosystem on National Forest System lands, hay, straw, and mulch must be certified weed free.
