The weather is quickly changes on the Mountain View District. Temperatures have dropped and we've had snow/rain off and on already this season. Most of the snow has not stuck to the roads, but there may be some patches throughout the forest and on the trails especially in the higher elevations. Muddy conditions may exist, especially on forest trails.

**Campgrounds-** Campgrounds are open, but with no amenities or fees this time of year.

**Roads & Access-** All roads on the district are accessible. There may be patchy snow throughout the trees off to the sides

**Henry's Fork Trail-** Trail might be muddy with patchy snow.

**King's Peak-** Covered in Snow

**Temperatures have been cold at night. Dress accordingly.**

**Be aware of your surroundings. Even though hazardous trees are being cleared on a regular basis, strong winds and beetle kill make forest trees prone to being toppled and can be dangerous.**
